



STEP THREE Installation the pickets.






What is Covered under the Limited Warranty

Subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, and exclusions of this limited warranty. Century Aluminum Products a division of CenDek Railings Ltd. ("Century"), warrants to the [original/first] [owner/consumer purchaser], as further defined herein, that the structure of Century Aluminum Railings (the "Products") will be free from material and manufacturing defects for a period of 20 years from the date of purchase. Century warrants the Powdercoat Paint (the "Powdercoat Paint") finish on the Products will not crack, chip, blister or lose paint adhesion for a period of 5 years from the date of purchase. Products that are located within one (1) mile of open ocean, or are otherwise located anywhere that heavy salt conditions (including but not limited to sea fog or salt water pools) prevail, in which case Century warrants that the Powdercoat Paint finish on the Products will not crack, chip, blister or lose paint adhesion for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase (hereinafter collectively, the "Limited Warranty").

Who is Covered under the Limited Warranty

This Limited Warranty is provided solely to the original consumer purchaser of the Products (the "Owner"), if that Owner lives within the United States or Canada. This Limited Warranty applies only to Products used in connection with either a single family detached housing unit or a detached duplex housing unit that is owned or occupied by the Owner and that is used solely for residential purposes (collectively, the "**Residential Location**").

Duration of the Limited Warranty

The duration of the Limited Warranty on defects in material and workmanship in the structure of the Products is 20 years from the date of original purchase of the Products. The duration of the Limited Warranty on the Powdercoat Paint finish is 5 years from the date of original purchase of the Products, *unless*, the Owner purchases the Products for use at a Residential Location that is located within one (1) mile of open ocean, or is otherwise located anywhere that heavy salt conditions (including but not limited to sea fog or salt water pools) prevail (a "Salt Condition Location"). If the Owner purchases the Products for use at a Salt Condition Location, the Limited Warranty on the Powdercoat Paint finish is one (1) year from the date of original purchase of the Products.

Conditions, Limitations and Exclusions

1. This Limited Warranty does not cover any Products that are not installed in accordance with Century's installation instructions, titled "Installation Instructions," and available at http://www.centuryrailings.com/search-by-product/ (the "Installation Instructions"). It is an express condition of this Limited Warranty that the Owner install the Products according to the directions set forth in the Installation Instructions. ACCORDINGLY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID AND CENTURY SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE PRODUCTS ARE INSTALLED THROUGH THE USE OF

SECTION SIX – WARRANTY 95

Section Six

IMPROPER METHODS, TECHNIQUES, OR FASTENERS, OR ARE OTHERWISE NOT INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS. Furthermore, this Limited Warranty does not cover Products that have been subject to welding, drilling, cutting or any other fabrication that is not called for in Century's Installation Instructions.

- 2. This Limited Warranty does not cover any Products that are not maintained in accordance with Century's care and maintenance instructions, titled "Care & Maintenance of Your Century Railings," and available at http://www.centuryrailings.com/wp-content/uploads/2016/09/Century-Care-Maintenance.pdf (the "Care and Maintenance Instructions"). It is an express condition of this Limited Warranty that the Owner maintain the Products according to the directions set forth in Century's Care and Maintenance Instructions. ACCORDINGLY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID AND CENTURY SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE OWNER DOES NOT COMPLY WITH CENTURY'S CARE AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS.
- 3. This Limited Warranty does not cover any Products that are not installed in accordance with applicable local building codes ("Local Building Codes"). It is an express condition of this Limited Warranty that the Owner install the Products according to applicable Local Building Codes. ACCORDINGLY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID AND CENTURY SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE OWNER DOES NOT COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE LOCAL BUILDING CODES.
- 4. This Limited Warranty does not cover screws or other fasteners, nor plastic, nor vinyl parts used in the assembly or installation of the Products.
- 5. This Limited Warranty does not cover damage to the Products due to usage, normal wear and tear or weathering (including, but not limited to, normal weathering due to the damaging effects of sunlight).
- 6. This Limited Warranty does not cover damage (including but not limited to surface deterioration, warping, cracking, crazing, distortion, chalking, scratching, fading, soiling, or staining) that is caused by abnormal, or extreme weather, or environmental conditions such as:.
- a. airborne stains:
- b. mold:
- c. mildew
- extreme weather (such as extreme cold temperatures, excessive heat sources or unusual or excessive reflective heat sources);
- e. extreme atmosphere (such as corrosive atmospheric contaminants **I.E.** chemical fumes, (air) pollution, seacoast environment, salt or salt air conditions) (See "DURATION OF LIMITED WARRANTY" FOR FURTHER LIMITATIONS TO THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE PRODUCTS ARE LOCATED IN A SALT CONDITION LOCATION).
- 7. This Limited Warranty does not cover claimed defects, malfunctions or failures of the Products resulting from misuse, abuse, or neglect, including but not limited to:
- a. improper storage prior to installation:
- b. improper installation, assembly or maintenance;
- c. exposure or subjection to abnormal residential use;
- accidental or intentional damage due to a collision, crash, vandalism, or the impact of foreign objects; and

e. the use of harmful or corrosive chemicals, including but not limited to, the use of harmful cleaning compounds, pesticides, fumes, harmful or corrosive products, or vapors.

Warranty

- 8. This Limited Warranty does not cover Products that have been damaged due to the settlement or the structural shrinkage, distortion or expansion of the structure of the Residential Location.
- 9. This Limited Warranty does not cover any Products that have been modified, altered or changed in any manner. It is an express condition of this Limited Warranty that the Products not be modified, altered or changed in any manner. ACCORDINGLY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID AND CENTURY SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE PRODUCTS HAVE BEEN MODIFIED, ALTERED OR CHANGED IN ANY MANNER.
- 10. This Limited Warranty is void and Century shall not have any responsibility or liability under this Limited Warranty if the Products are combined or used with a competitor's products or systems.
- 11. This Limited Warranty does not cover Products that were not purchased in new condition from an authorized Century dealer. A list of authorized Century dealers is available at http://www.centuryrailings.com/dealer-locator/ It is an express condition of this Limited Warranty that the Products be purchased in new condition from an authorized Century dealer. ACCORDINGLY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID AND CENTURY SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE PRODUCTS WERE NOT PURCHASED IN NEW CONDITION FROM AN AUTHORIZED CENTURY DEALER.
- 12. This Limited Warranty does not cover Products that are installed in Residential Locations that experience winds exceeding 60 miles per hour (96 kilometers per hour). It is an express condition of this Limited Warranty that the Products be installed in Residential Locations that experience winds of less than 60 miles per hour (96 kilometers per hour). ACCORDINGLY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID AND CENTURY SHALL NOT HAVE ANY RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IF THE PRODUCTS ARE INSTALLED IN RESIDENTIAL LOCATIONS THAT EXPERIENCE WINDS EXCEEDING 60 MILES PER HOUR (96 KILOMETERS PER HOUR). IF THE OWNER IS UNSURE ABOUT WIND CONDITIONS IN HIS OR HER RESIDENTIAL LOCATION, THE OWNER SHOULD CONSULT A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER TO DETERMINE IF THE PRODUCTS ARE SUITABLE FOR THE RESIDENTIAL LOCATION.
- 13. This Limited Warranty does not cover any problems which result from conditions beyond Century's control including, but not limited to, acts of God (such as floods, earthquakes, hurricanes, tornados, volcanoes and volcanic ash, lightning, windstorm, hail or fires), government restrictions, or domestic or international problems such as wars or insurrections, strikes, explosions, riots, civil disturbances, and/or labor disputes, or any other causes beyond Century's control.

Non-Assignable and Non-Transferable; Termination of Limited Warranty; Limited Warranty Extends Only to First Consumer Purchaser

This Limited Warranty is NON-ASSIGNABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE. Accordingly, coverage under this Limited Warranty WILL TERMINATE UPON ASSIGNMENT OR TRANSFER OF THE PRODUCTS AND/OR THE RESIDENTIAL LOCATION to subsequent and non-original purchasers or owners.

Warranty

What The Purchaser Must Do To Get Limited Warranty Service

To make a claim under this Limited Warranty, the Owner must send a claim, (a blank copy is available at http://www.centuryrailings.com/wp-content/uploads/2016/08/century-warranty-claim-form-fillable.pdf) in writing (the "Claim") to Century within 14 days of the discovery of the defect or circumstances giving rise to the Claim. The Purchaser must mail the Claim to Century Aluminum Products 9685 Agur St.

Summerland, B.C. Canada V0H1Z2. The Claim must include: 1) a full description of the defect; 2) photographs of the defect; and 3) the original purchase receipt from an authorized Century dealer for the Products. Century shall then have a reasonable opportunity to investigate the Claim before it is required to provide any relief under this Limited Warranty, and Century will not be required to provide relief pursuant to this Limited Warranty without being given a reasonable opportunity to investigate the Claim. During its investigation, Century may request additional information from the Purchaser in order to determine whether all conditions set forth in this Limited Warranty have been satisfied, and whether any limitations or exclusions may apply. The Owner must respond promptly to Century's requests for such additional information.

What Century Will Do Under The Limited Warranty

If, after investigating a Claim made under this Limited Warranty, Century determines that the Products are defective and that the Claim under this Limited Warranty is valid, Century will repair or replace the Products, or any part of the Products deemed defective by Century, at Century's discretion. This will be the sole remedy available under this Limited Warranty. In no event shall the liability of Century exceed the purchase price of the defective Products. In the event of repair or replacement under this Limited Warranty, the Limited Warranty applicable to the replacement material or to the repaired Products will extend only for the time remaining under this Limited Warranty.

Century reserves the right to discontinue or change the design or color of the Products at any time and without notice or liability. Century does not **guarantee** that replacement Products provided by Century in connection with this Limited Warranty will match the design or color of the original Products. If, for any reason, Products are no longer available from Century at the time that Century acknowledges that a Claim will be covered under this Limited Warranty, Century may substitute other Products determined in its sole discretion to be of comparable quality and price.

What Century Will Not Do Under The Limited Warranty

To the extent permitted by applicable law, Century will not pay for any labor, installation, non-Products materials (including, but not limited to, screws or other fasteners), shipping, removal and/or disposal costs incurred in connection with the repair or replacement of the Products (the "Uncovered Costs"). The Uncovered Costs, along with any additional costs and expenses beyond the original purchase price of the Products, shall be the Owner's sole responsibility and are excluded from coverage under this Limited Warranty.

Limitation of Damages

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, IN NO EVENT SHALL CENTURY BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, EXEMPLARY OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES FOR: LOSS OF BUSINESS OR PROFITS, INJURY OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OR PERSONS, OR ANY LABOR OR OTHER COSTS OR EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH REPAIRING AND/OR REPLACING THE PRODUCTS), WHETHER FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY, BREACH OF CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE. IN NO

EVENT SHALL THE LIABILITY OF CENTURY EXCEED THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE PRODUCTS.

Some states and provinces do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.

Limitation of Express Warranties

NO ORAL OR WRITTEN ADVICE, RECOMMENDATION, AFFIRMATION OF FACT, DESCRIPTION OF GOODS, OR SPECIFICATION RELATING TO THE PRODUCTS SHALL CONSTITUTE, OR BE DEEMED TO CONSTITUTE, A WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO THE PRODUCTS. CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES FOR YOUR CENTURY RAILINGS

Maintaining the good looks of your powder coated products is just like caring for your car – and is a smart way to protect your investment. Over time with exposure to the elements, powder coatings may show signs of weathering such as loss of gloss, chalking and slight colour change. A simple regular clean will minimize the effects of weathering and will remove dirt, grime and other build-up detrimental to all powder coatings. Clean the aluminum components of the rail with warm soapy water using a sponge or soft cloth. Do not use any types of abrasive cleaners that may scratch the railing. For stubborn stains consult your **Century** representative.

Cleaning should start at the time the products are installed, ensuring that construction materials such as concrete, plaster and paint splashes are removed before they have a chance to dry. Failure to remove these materials at this early stage will require the use of aggressive cleaning materials and techniques with potential damage to the powder coated surface.

If the product is installed within one (1) mile of a coastline, saltwater bay, or any area prone to saltwater spray, there are additional and specific maintenance requirements within these installation, care, and maintenance instructions that apply. **Century Aluminum Railing Systems** will require cleaning and caring for the exterior aluminum surfaces. Annual inspections are sufficient for most areas; however coastal areas have special requirements.

Product Cleaning:

For light cleaning, rinse with water from bottom to top and back to bottom. This will clean the surface on the way up and prevent the collection of dirty "run down" and possible streaking. Air dry or wipe dry with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.

If light cleaning does not clean the debris, rinse the surface with clean water from top to bottom. Use a sponge and clean with mild soap and water. Immediately rinse any "run down" to lower parts of the building. Do not allow cleaning solutions to collect or "puddle" on surfaces. Immediately rinse with clean water. It is very important that cleaning solution does not dry on the surface. Air or wipe dry with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn, water-soluble debris, repeat steps above until clean.

Do not clean coated aluminum surfaces in direct sunlight or in temperatures too hot or too cold. Do not use abrasive cleaners that may scratch the cladding and avoid excessive rubbing or over-cleaning. Apply wax to all exposed fasteners every 3-6 months to help prevent oxidation. This should be performed more frequently if product is located in high salt content areas.

Cleaning of Brick and Concrete:

The cleaning solutions used on both brick and concrete contain strong chemicals that can cause damage to the powder-coated surface. All exposed powder-coated surfaces should be fully protected. If any such solutions or chemicals come in contact with the powder-coated surface, wash immediately with copious amounts of water.

Prolonged exposure can cause discoloration of the film, loss of gloss and damage to the coating surface.

Care and Maintenance

Recommended Maintenance Schedule:

Aluminum handrails and guardrails are intended to provide both safety and aesthetics for the life of the structure to which they are installed. **Century Aluminum Railing Systems** recommends that the following actions be undertaken:

- 1. Railing should be hand washed with mild detergent and rinsed with clean water as needed every 6-12 months.
- 2. All screws should be checked every year for snugness. Caulking should be removed and replaced if showing signs of deterioration. If screws require replacing, replace them with appropriate fasteners.
- 3. Guardrails fastened to concrete decks should be inspected carefully on an annual basis at each plate for evidence of moisture leakage or loose connections.

The frequency of such cleaning will depend on many factors including:

- The geographical location of the building
- The environment surrounding the building, i.e., marine, swimming pool, industrial, or a combination of these environments
- Levels of atmospheric pollution
- Prevailing winds
- Protection of the building by other buildings
- Possibility of airborne debris (e.g., sand/dust etc.) causing erosive wear of the coating
- If the environmental circumstances change during the lifetime of the building
- The powder coating chemistry

The frequency of cleaning depends in part on the standard of appearance that is required and also the requirements to remove deposits, which could, during prolonged contact with either the powder film or the metal substrate, (if exposed) cause damage.

Sheltered areas can be more at risk of coating degradation than exposed areas. This is because windblown salt and other pollutants may adhere to the surface and will not be cleaned away with rainfall. These areas should be inspected and cleaned if necessary on a more regular basis.

Vinyl Baseplate Covers can be cleaned or brought back to life with aftermarket products such as RECOLOUR or similar revitalizing vinyl products. (It is recommended to remove and store your baseplate cover indoors out of the elements over the winter months). Vinyl Baseplate Covers may be glued together with a silicone, or vinyl adhesive to avoid separation at the connection points if so desired.

Coastline Maintenance Requirements:

The salt and moisture in the air of such regions can create a damaging buildup of salt on the railing components. This damaging build-up requires monthly inspections of all railing components to detect and subsequently remove the harmful residue. If upon detection of any salty build-up, monthly cleaning of the aluminum surface may be required to regain the product's original look, quality and luster and to maintain its warranty eligibility.

(NOTE: Any evidence of these anomalies should be reported to your **Century** dealer or technical representative for further action. It is the sole responsibility of the owner to maintain the railings in accordance with these care and maintenance instructions. Failure to follow these instructions may void the warranty.)
